Exchange Program Period (Research Internship)	2 months (60-62days) between January 7th and March 15th, 2016. * I recommend Program Start Date: January 8th (Thursday) & Program End Date: March 10th (Tuesday) (Total 62 days) * If the participant wants to stay a few days longer, then, January 7th (Wednesday) till March 13th (Friday) (Total 66 days) is possible, however, the Jasso scholarship can be paid only for 2 months x JPY80,000.
Support Details	University Guest House (Shoryo Club) and hotel accommodation during the stay (During the above period, the university entrance examination will be held for 2-3 days. For these exam days, the student will be required to vacate NUT guesthouse, and stay in a designated hotel.) (Total approximately 200,000yen for Guesthouse/Hotel will be covered by NUT)
	Domestic round-trip train ticket (Between Airport Station and Nagaoka Station)
	Living Expenses: JASSO scholarship 80,000yen/month x 2 months (for students who meet the eligibility requirements: Grade 2.3/3.0 and above)
