To apply, students should provide two to three letters of recommendation, a statement of purpose, and unofficial transcripts. We do accept waivers for English language proficiency. APPLICATION MATERIAL REQUIREMENTS

Materials vary by master's program and are dependent on the program selected in your application.

Materials

- Letters of Recommendation: REQUIRED (2-3, varies by program)
- Statement of Purpose: REQUIRED for all
- Resume/CV: Required/Optional (varies by program)
- Personal Statement: OPTIONAL
- Unofficial Transcripts: REQUIRED (for every college/university attended)

Application Fee

- No application fee for Fall 2026 applicants

Graduate Record Exam (GRE)

- No GRE required for Fall 2026 applicants

English Language Proficiency

- Tests accepted: TOEFL, IELTS, or Cambridge
- NOT Accepted: Duolingo or TOEFL Essentials Test
- Waiver requests are accepted. Applicants can submit a waiver request directly in the application. Applicants can select "Language of Instruction" as the reason for the waiver.
- Programs will use unofficial test scores for review while awaiting the officials scores from the Testing Agency.
