Conditions

- Early-career researchers (enrolled as students or up to 10 years post-degree) individuals in ocean science and/or other marine-related topics.
- Deliver an oral presentation or poster at ICOE2025, Chennai.
- Participants from <u>developing countries</u> (<u>listed here</u>) can apply. Participants from India will not be considered.
- Have not received a SCOR travel grant within the past 2 years.

Application process

Applications for travel support must include the following:

- (1) Name and full contact details, country
- (2) Current status (e.g. PhD student (please indicate the year of study)/Post Doc/Research Associate/Faculty member),
- (3) Abstract (200 words)
- (4) A letter expressing the applicant's research interests and interest in participating in the conference
- (5) A supporting letter from the applicant's adviser, supervisor, or organization official and
- (6) An overview of expected expenses, including registration fees, airfare, and accommodation.
