Funding for Mobility Programs Many universities are willing to put in money to grow their partnership with IIT Madras There is an expectation of matching funds from IIT Madras We have hundreds of MOUs and 19 JDPs * Mobility has been largely from IIT Madras to the partner university * It has been difficult to correct this imbalance It is important to get international students to pursue graduate study at IIT Madras * Enrich the research atmosphere * Improve ranking metrics



- Fund joint mobility programs with partner universities
- IIT Madras puts in up to 50,000 USD for 2-3 years for a particular university collaboration
- The partner university puts in an equivalent amount
- This funding is deployed for use in IITM-Bilateral mobility program
 - * Jointly administered
 - * Call for proposals
 - * Mobility can be used for JDP and JMP students
 - * This will hopefully start to address the imbalance between inbound and outbound students
 - * Faculty mobility could also be budgeted
 - * Competitive grant evaluation by a joint committee
- Look at seeding about 10 of these
- Based on outcomes, decide the way forward





2. Do you currently have active international collaboration(s), excluding your doctoral/ post-doctoral supervisor/ institute?





3. What is the mode of your current collaboration?







4. If you are not collaborating with international partners, do you wish to have an international collaboration?






5. Do you think international collaboration is important, necessary, and complementary to your research at IIT Madras?







6. Did you ever approach anyone in one of the top 20 QS universities (if you are not collaborating already) with a collaboration proposal?






7. If the answer to question 6 is no, what do you think were the potential reasons?
