

## 1. FY2023 OGGs Program



1. Students who are equivalent to either condition of (1)-(3) as of April 2023.
  - (1) Students who are enrolled in a graduate degree program and will continuously be enrolled during independent research experience period.
  - (2) Students who [will] have acquired Bachelor's degree, and will enter Master program in Jan. or Jul. 2023.
  - (3) Students who are in third year in Bachelor's degree program, and will continuously be enrolled in Bachelor's program during independent research experience period.
2. Students whose GPA is above 2.30/3.00 over the last one year.

\*Visa fees, etc. are at your own expense.

#### 4. Financial Support and enrollment capacity

**8 students** for each IIT are called for OGGs program FY 2023

◆ With financial support from Hokkaido University: **4 students**

**Basic Program** (2 months)

- JASSO Scholarship: 80,000 Yen/month    3 students from each IIT
- Air fee support: 50,000 Yen                1 student from each IIT

**Advanced Program** (3-8 months)

- JASSO Scholarship: 80,000 Yen/month    1 student from each IIT
- Air fee support: 200,000 Yen (max.)        1 student from each IIT

\* The number of students who can get the JASSO scholarship may change depending on the result.

◆ Without financial support from Hokkaido University: **4 students**

Basic Program + Advanced Program = 4 students for each IIT

#### 5. Expenses

Students are responsible for the followings.

- Travel Expense
- Overseas travel insurance
- Visa-related expenses
- Other living expenses (e.g. Dormitory fees, food, transportation, etc.)
- Dormitory and utility fees during the OGGs Program period: approx. 30,000 – 40,000 Yen/month
- Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Coupled with "Gakkensai" (when you arrive Japan, we will instruct you)
- (Advanced Program only) National Health Insurance(Japanese governmental Insurance): approx. 2,000 Yen/month

#### 5. Application

End of December 2022: Deadline at Hokkaido University

\*Please check the designated deadline at your home university and submit all application documents by E-mail through the section in charge of OGGs-STSI program at your home university by that date. Original application documents will be requested later.

\*Please note that there will be screening at your home university.

#### 6. Other points to note

- Any funding will not be provided under any circumstances to students unable to remain in Japan for the period specified by the Central Office for the OGGs Program.
- Students are responsible for expenses relating to personal trips and home-country visits regardless the circumstances.
- Students should take out overseas travel insurance before leaving your country for the program.
- Students are **NOT** allowed to trip around in Japan for sightseeing before OGGs program starts.
- Students must send e-tickets of the flight tickets to OGGs central office in advance.

## OGGs Program Application Instructions for FY 2023

**STEP1** Submit the application documents to OGGs-STSI office of your university

- 1) FY2023 OGGs Application Form
- 2) Academic transcript of home institution of last one year (Translated in English)
- 3) Official Certificate of Enrollment of home University (in English)
- 4) Copy of passport
- 5) Copy of Official English proficiency test certificate

**\*Please check the designated deadline at your home university** and submit all application documents by E-mail through the section in charge of OGGs-STSI program at your home university by that date. Original application documents will be requested later.

**\*Please note that there will be screening at your home university.**

**STEP2-A** Submit the ORIGINAL documents to OGGs central office by Air mail  
**(For Long -term applicants, short-term applicants who are undergraduate students)**

Deadline for submission: **MARCH 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023**

We will send the necessary instruction to liaison office according to which department of graduate school accepts applicant. (\* For each department has its own instruction)

All **ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS** must be delivered to OGGs central office by Air mail.

Please note that the documents must be shipped from the section in charge of OGGs-STSI program at your home university collectively

**(Not from each student).**

**STEP2-B** Apply through website of HSI after we inform you the selected notification  
**(For Basic Program applicants who are Master or PhD student)**

Deadline for submission: **MARCH 6<sup>st</sup> ~ 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023.**

We will inform you the selected notification.
