Basic Program	Graduate students	June - Sept. 2024 (2~3 months)	Acquire ability to work with people from different fields/culture through teamwork research
Advanced Program	Graduate students	June 2024 - Feb. 2025 (3~8 months)	Acquire expertise in their own specialized fields and engage in the teamwork research as a leader

Application Qualification

Students who fulfill all the conditions of 1-2 below.

1. Students who are equivalent to either condition of (1)-(3) as of June 2024.

- (1) Students who are enrolled in a graduate degree program (Master / Ph. D) and will continuously be enrolled during participation.
- (2) Students who [will] have acquired Bachelor's degree and will enter Master program by the beginning of the participation in the program.

2. Students whose GPA is above 2.30/3.00 over the last one year.
